Letter of understanding between B.C. Railway and C.U.T.E. local No. 1
Pertaining to Article 5.7, "Engineemen called Remain until Relieved to fill a
vacancy at outlying points who subsequently becomes successful by bid to
another position.

An engineer called remained until relieved at an outlying point, who is
subsequently successful to a position by bid will be released if there is more
than 50% of the vacancy left. (Over The Hump)

On the over the hump day there must be sufficient time to replace the
successful applicant, if not the successful applicant will be expected to
protect the assignment for that day. The employee will then be released upon
completion of shift.

This Letter of Understanding will remain in effect unless cancelled by either
party on 30 days notice.
